

Help conduct Al-Anon meetings for inmates

Perryville is a state prison for women located near the intersection of I-10 and Loop 303 in the West Valley. It includes facilities ranging from minimum to maximum security. Meetings are currently in medium security.

You will conduct meetings with at least one other Al-Anon volunteer. Volunteers often carpool to the prison.

For many inmates, prison meetings are their first exposure to recovery. They learn tools that help them during incarceration and carry with them as they re-enter society. As with any service commitment, volunteers often grow as much as those they came to serve.

It's like attending any Al-Anon meeting. Inmates run the meetings with guidance from volunteers. Volunteers share their experience, strength, and hope and model the Al-Anon program to the inmates.
